We are reconnecting again with you about the digital and non-digital **pick up/drop off schedule** for the remainder of 2021. **Below is an update of the new dates.** You will continue to be able to drop off and then pick up the non-digital learning materials for your child here at our <u>Main Office between 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.</u> based on the <u>updated schedule (below)</u>. For digital learners, you will **continue to use the digital learning platform for your child's classroom**. Please, continue to return completed digital learning materials as arranged with your child's teacher.

It is important that <u>all your child's learning materials are returned</u> based on the guidance of your child's teacher and through our bi-weekly schedule. This allows our teachers to review it and provide feedback. The returned materials will guide the teacher's planning for next steps in learning, as well the information will support their reporting in the February and June Report Cards. If you cannot come to Maynard on the scheduled day for any reason, just call us and we will support you.

I.Prior to coming to Maynard to pick up/drop off learning materials, parents/guardians or any appointed persons must complete Ontario's <u>COVID-19 self-assessment</u> tool prior to accessing any school property.

i.If the individual answers NO to all questions, they have passed the screening and can advance to receive/drop off packages.

ii. If the individual answers YES to any of the screening questions, then they have failed the screening and cannot advance to receive/drop off packages. It is recommended that they go to an Assessment Centre or contact their health care provider. If any individual refuses to answer the questions, they are to make other arrangements to receive/drop off packages.

We will continue to work with you as **we must ensure physical distancing, wearing a mask or face covering and performing hand hygiene before and after handling items.** Please look for our **pickup/drop off table** outside our Main Office doors. Just ring the bell and we will support the transition of learning materials.
