## **May Parent Council Teacher Report**

**Ms. Howes / Mrs. Brown:** About four to five students have been logging on regularly for synchronous learning. Other students have been doing a great job with their asynchronous work. The kids are loving how to draw videos and they complete one almost daily.

Mrs. Geggie / Mrs. Young: They have been learning about living things and what living things need to survive. They have also been conducting some science experiments to practice making predictions and observations.

**Mrs. Nolan:** Their class has been exploring communities in social studies. They will be taking some virtual field trips to explore different communities globally, focusing on climate and different ways of life.

**Mrs. Brennan:** Last week their weekly activity challenge was to build a fort. The kids have had fun planning and building and repairing when it crashes.

**Ms. Scott:** Students have been really engaging in nature. Monday's are called "Mystery Monday" – we watch a video on open ended topics. Last weeks was "What's Making All that Noise in the Swamp?" Each day, I played an animal noise and they had to guess what animal it was. After, we did a shared reading on that animal and integrated that knowledge throughout our day together. This weeks topic is: The Dandelion: Weed or Flower?

**Mrs. Baker / Mrs. Wilson:** Students are starting to work on their culminating project on habitats by creating a diorama. They are also going to spend some time exploring coding and learning about robots.

**Ms. Lawrence:** Painted kindness rocks last week and will be cooking on Friday - kids choose from 4 options and we do together or they can create it on the weekend with family.

Mrs. Marshall: Students just finished their fantasy fiction unit and are starting a media unit in language.

French: Finishing up their bodily health unit and in June they will learning about summer vocabulary.
