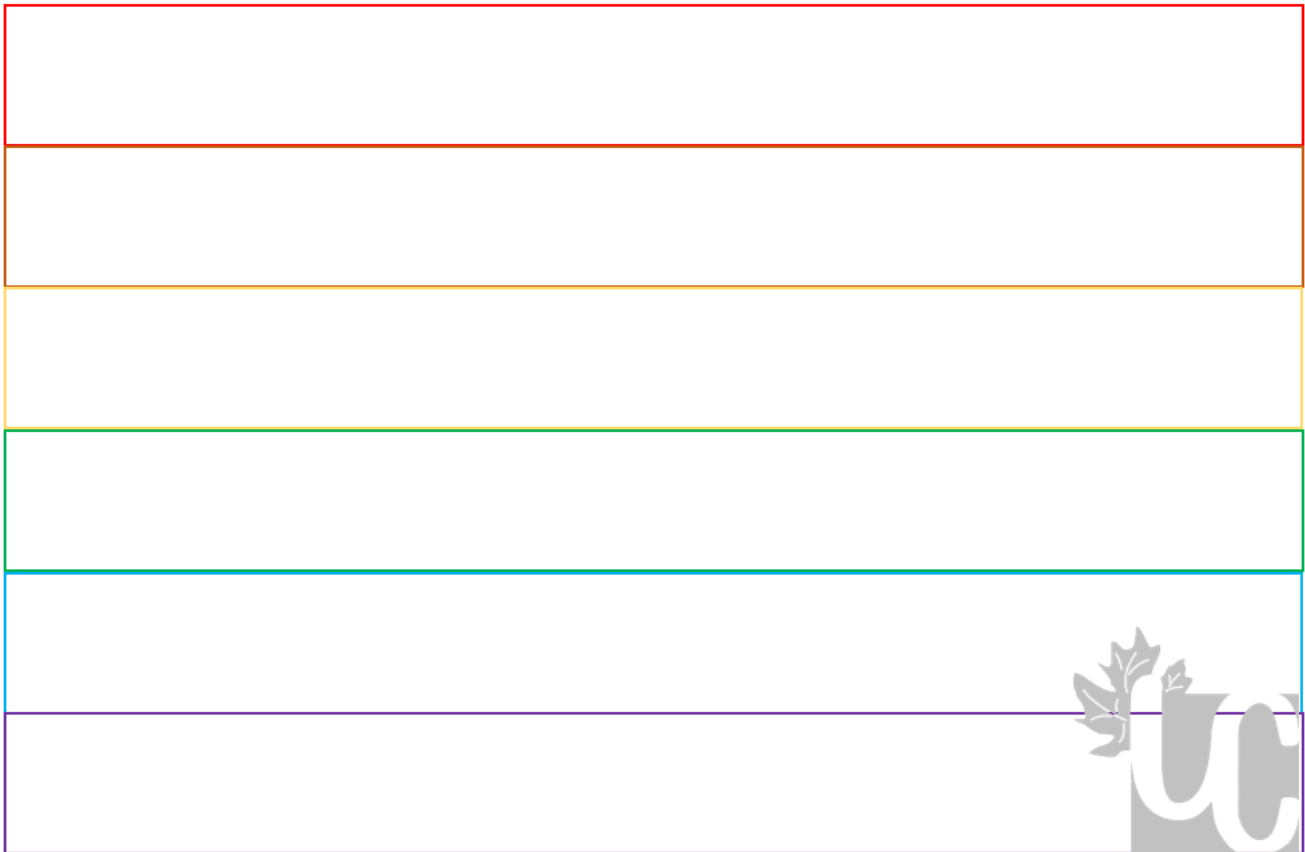


THIS IS A SAFE SPACE
